

MECHANICS FOR ENTRIES

- The nominated visual artist must be a Filipino citizen below 36 years old on 31 May 2018.
- 2. The artworks submitted for nomination must have appeared in a solo or group show within the twelve months preceding 2 May 2018.
- 3. Visual art is defined, for the purpose of the Ateneo Art Awards, as paintings, drawings, original fine prints, photographs, sculptures, assemblages, installations, performance and new media works (film, video, computer and other technologies).
- All nomination forms must be accompanied by visual documentation. Nominations must bTe received at the following address before 5PM on 31 May 2018:

7. Documentation of still artworks in video is limited to a maximum of 2 minutes. While there is no time limit for time-based/video artworks or of video documentation of performance, we advise you to send the video 1-2 weeks before the deadline to give Jurors enough time to view the work.

- 10. All images of artworks submitted for consideration should be properly labelled as follows:

Each nominated exhibition may be represented by up to six (6) images (1-2 images per nominated artwork with a maximum of four works for each nomination) plus a maximum of six (6) installation shots if the nominator feels that the installation was crucial to the show. In case of a series nominated as one work, documentation for each piece in the series will be accepted.
- 12. For the initial round of judging, the jury will be basing its decisions solely on the visual documentation submitted by the nominator. High resolution images are encouraged.
- 13. All decisions made by the Jury with regard to the qualification of the nominated visual artist, the artworks submitted for consideration and the 2018 Ateneo Art Awards shortlist, winners and residency grants are final.
- 14. Awarding ceremony tentatively scheduled for 26 August 2018 at the Arts Wing, Areté, Ateneo de Manila University.

To further promote contemporary art practice and enrich the Philippine cultural landscape, the Ateneo Art Gallery and its partners give recognition and opportunities to Filipino visual artists below the age of 36 through the Ateneo Art Awards - Fernando Zóbel Prizes for Visual Art. Since 2004, outstanding works and exhibitions by young visual artists are duly recognized through this de Ayala (1924-1984), the founding benefactor of the

Celebrating the best of contemporary art in the Philippines, the Fernando Zóbel Prizes for Visual Art are given to three (3) artists from a shortlist of twelve (12). They will be eligible for international residency grants funded by Ateneo Art Gallery and its partner institutions: La Trobe Art Institute, La Trobe University

in Bendigo, Australia; The Creative Campus, Liverpool Hope University in Liverpool, United Kingdom; and Artesan Gallery + Studio in Singapore. The selection of residency grant recipients is made by the host
